#### Naviance and College Applications

- Student applies to colleges
  - Common Application, SUNY, Institutional
- Student enters colleges in **Naviance** 
  - For Common App Schools: Students will match the account with Naviance
  - For Non-Common App Schools: Students must enter each college manually
- Student requests transcripts/teacher recommendations in **Naviance**
- Student monitors progress in **Naviance**
- Student records outcomes & requests final transcript for chosen college in

**Naviance** 



#### Points to Consider...

Use same name & email in Naviance & college apps
Use only full legal name, no nicknames

Common Application (CA) applications automatically sync in Naviance via Matching Process

#### Letters of Recommendation


Click "add request"

#### I've Applied....now what?







When submitting your application via Common App, Naviance will automatically update to let your counselor know. For other application types, you must "edit" the information.

Update your Naviance by clicking "I've submitted my application" and save







Next, request your **Initial** transcript. **ALL** students must do this, even those using Common App.

All students must put a result in Naviance for **EVERY** school they applied to.







#### Updating your Final Choice

#### How to Prepare for the 2025-2026 FAFSA Form

Will be open on or before December 1st, 2024

You can create a
StudentAid.gov account
ahead of time



Visit studentaid.gov website to review information

Prepare the following documents:

- Parent SSN's (if they have and you are a dependent student)
- Tax Returns
- Records of child support recieved
- Current balances of cash, checkings, and savings accounts
- Net worth of investments/businesses

#### CUNY Free Application Week

November 4th -November 15th

Apply to any CUNY school during this time frame for free!

### Timeline of Senior Year: September



- Review your transcript
- Parent/Guardian fills out transcript release form
- Work on completing college applications and essays
- Ask one or two teachers for letters of recommendation through Naviance (after speaking with them)
- Early Decision and Early Action candidates make sure your counselor is aware of your deadlines
- Register for your final SAT/ACT if needed, and send your scores
- Attend financial aid workshops
- Check the Guidance Newsletter monthly for scholarship information
- Register with NCAA if you plan to play a Division 1 or 2 sport in college
- Keep your grades up! Most colleges will want to see your Senior year mid-year grades

### Timeline of Senior Year: October/November




- Complete your college essay and speak with your English teacher to help you review it
- Discuss your college plan with your counselor and finalize your college list
- Early Decision candidates should complete their applications
- Pay attention to application deadlines!
  - Please allow enough lead time for both teachers and counselors to process information
- Early Decision and Early Action candidates make sure your counselor is aware of your deadlines
- Continue working on college applications
- Early Decision deadlines are as early as November 1st or November 15th!

### Timeline of Senior Year: December/January



- FAFSA will be available on or before December 1st
   2024- complete as early as possible
- Complete all college applications by December 15th if possible
- Pay attention to December and January 1st deadlines. Notify your counselor of your deadlines
- Notify your counselor of colleges that are requesting mid-year grades (for Non-Common Application schools)
- Get application packet for PM Scholarships & Awards

### Timeline of Senior Year: February/March/April



- Colleges will inform students of admissions decisions
- Keep the counselor informed of your decision of where you plan to attend!
- When you have decided on a school, send your deposit, and inform other schools so your spot can go to someone on the waiting list
- Continue to research scholarship opportunities

### Timeline of Senior Year: May/June



- Carefully analyze your financial aid award letters
- Inform the Admissions Office of the school you have decided to attend
- List your acceptances and denials in Naviance for ALL colleges you have applied to
- Request your FINAL transcript through Naviance
