




GRADE 6 WHAT MODEL WOULD YOU PREFER?






GRADE 12 WHAT MODEL WOULD YOU PREFER?






DO YOU SUPPORT IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION ON WEDNESDAYS?

FULL REMOTE OPTION

- Allows students to remain in their regularly scheduled classes but will require them to live stream each day from home to attend all classes at their regularly scheduled time.
- Students who do not log in for a scheduled class will be marked absent for that specific class.
- Students on Full Remote are not required to log in for lunch or any scheduled study halls.
- We anticipate Full Remote for newly enrolled students will go into effect the week of February 22, 2021.

- Parents will have the option of remaining on Full Remote for the 4th Marking Quarter or they may select to re-enroll their child(ren) for in-person instruction.
- Re-enrollment will take place the week of April 12-April 16. Parents must notify the Office of Instructional Services to re-enroll for in-person instruction.
- As always, families can speak with the building principal if they face unforeseen circumstances or challenges during their remote learning.
